In February 2011, the Alpaka Schau Süd GbR laid the foundation for today's Alpaka Marketing GbR and thus the start for the first „Alpaca Show South“ in the ARENA Hohenlohe in Ilshofen.

In the beginning, the show was relatively small with 120 animals, but very impressive for everyone. In 2018, the show counted almost five hundred alpacas, making it the largest alpaca show on the European continent at the time! In autumn of the same year, the „World of Alpacas“ show took place in the Schwabenhalle Buchloe.

To this day, the principle of Alpaka Marketing GbR is: All alpaca breeders can participate in the shows without major restrictions.

The bluetongue disease put a quick end to the events in the restricted areas, which is why Alpaka Marketing GbR moved to the bluetongue-free alternative location in Bayreuth. Bayreuth also hosted the very last Alpaca Show South shortly before the outbreak of the Corona pandemic in March 2020.

In the spring of 2020, another field of activity was added to the corporation with the takeover of ALLESPAKA. The Alpaka Schau GbR grew, re-organized and from then on officially called itself Alpaka Marketing Kuhne-Pfaff & Klink GbR.

Due to the corona epidemic the International Alpaca Fleece Show was performed contactless in summer as well as the International Alpaca Photoshow in autumn of 2020.

The „World of Alpacas“ show is to be continued at the new location Osterhofen, since the Buchloe location closed its doors after the 10th show in 2021.

After the pandemic subsided and due to the shortage of staff in the catering industry, Alpaka Marketing GbR took over the catering during the show in 2021.

After a four-year break in Ilshofen, the 12th Alpaca Show South 2023 in the ARENA Hohenlohe was once again the largest alpaca show in Germany with almost four hundred alpacas, many innovations such as the live stream, and a record number of visitors.

Alpaka Marketing GbR owes its unbridled success to an excellently working show team of thirty members, generous supporters through advertisements, stud fees, sponsors, and well-known show judges over these years. We would like to take this opportunity to express our special thanks to all of them!

With the World Alpaca Conference 2025 and the cooperation of the German organizations AAeV, AZVD, NWK, AELAS and LAREU for this probably unique event, Alpaka Marketing GbR is taking a new path of cooperation.

We are looking forward to 2025!

Arturo Pena | USA

Judges the Fleece Show AAe.V.



Arturo Pena comes from Arequipa, Peru, and has made a name for himself in the USA as a renowned alpaca expert. His role as operations manager of well-known alpaca breeding farms laid the foundation for his impressive career.

With a sound education in veterinary medicine and a bachelor's degree in management, Arturo deepened his knowledge.

Before his alpaca career, he organized dog shows and discovered his passion for travel at a tour operator in Peru.

Today, he organizes educational trips to Peru that offer insights into the alpaca world. As an AOA-certified judge and member of the AOA Judges Advisory Committee (JAC), he has served in the U.S., Canada, and Europe. Arturo sees continuous education as the key to success in the alpaca industry.

His contribution to scientific research, in particular his study of alpaca antibodies, has been accepted for publication in the scientific journal *Theriogenology*. In addition to his professional work, he is involved in the library and the Cornell University Cooperative Extension to raise awareness of the alpaca industry in his community.

In North Salem, New York, Arturo enjoys life with his wife Kat, their son Nicholas, as they share a love of taking alpaca pictures.

Dr. Birgit Fürst-Waltl is a Senior Lecturer in Livestock Sciences at the University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences, Vienna (BOKU), Austria.

In addition to teaching and supervising

students, her focus is on functional traits, the development and improvement of genetic evaluation and the definition of total merit indices within breeding programs.

In this context, she cooperates closely with the relevant organizations. She mostly works with ruminants but has also been involved in projects dealing with other livestock species.

Amanda VandenBosch | USA

Amanda VandenBosch has been raising alpacas, both huacaya and suris for 32 + years along with her family at Flying Dutchman Alpacas, LLC in Bend, Oregon, USA. Amanda travels worldwide as an International Alpaca Judge, judging and

teaching on all aspects of alpacas, fiber, and end products.

She has been active with many organizations and is co-author of „Art & Science of Alpaca Judging“ and „Innovative Fleece Assessment Judging Sys-

tem“ along with many research projects related to selection, health, and wellbeing of the alpaca.

Proud co-host of the 15th Annual Education with an event on site, and Stanford Livestock International, Ltd export services complimented with the alpaca retail store Alpaca by Design. Amanda is passionately involved with the non-profit organization Quechua Benefit in Peru.

Amanda is an alpaca enthusiast in all aspects from selective breeding decisions and raising high-quality alpacas to a passionate educator known for her interactive clinics and sharing of knowledge with fellow alpaca enthusiasts worldwide.

Norm Evans | USA

9:00 a.m.– 10:15 a.m., Research Results on Medullation (together with A. VandenBosch)



Norm Evans has been a camelid veterinarian for over 35 years. His focus has been on the role of nutrition of alpacas throughout their lifecycle, including different stages of gestation and cria growth. He has placed special

emphasis on the effect of various diets on fiber quality and quantity throughout the life of the alpaca.

Alpacas are generally safe to work with and treat, from a veterinary perspective. Alpaca owners care about their animals' wellbeing and seem very re-

ceptive to ideas that can improve their health and fiber production.

Norm has observed that alpacas can adapt to many different environments, from small hobby farms to large ranches, in time. In the last twenty years, fifty percent of his clients were new breeders, a positive sign for the future of the alpaca industry.

In his 45-minute presentation he will share his knowledge of the impact certain nutrients consumed during critical periods will have on alpaca health, cria development and fiber production. He emphasizes the importance of the proper management of the proteins, vitamins and minerals present in pasture, hay, water, and commercial feeds as these factors can influence alpaca health and fiber quality for life.

Christian Van der Ham | NL

11:00 a.m.– 11:45 a.m., Tourism and Alpacas



Christiaan Van der Ham, an experienced professional in the tourism industry, holds a master's in international heritage management. With roots in the tourism industry, he started working in education. He trains students for

their career and coordinates internships together with a colleague.

As alumni coordinator, Christian maintains close contact with university graduates worldwide. He regularly visits companies, trade fairs and conferences to keep up to date with current de-

velopments. His interest in alpacas was awakened by his professional network as more and more graduates immersed themselves in the sector. Christian recognized the growing relevance and versatility of the alpaca industry.

Alpacas, with their sustainable fiber and charm, have a special appeal. Christian sees a promising future for the alpaca industry, especially in connection with tourism.

In his 45-minute presentation, he plans to shed light on this link. He will discuss company strategies and approaches that sustainably integrate alpacas into tourism and compare international examples. His goal is to show innovative ways in which animals can be ethically and economically integrated into tourism.

12:00 p.m. – 12:45 p.m., Alpaca Fleece Processing in Italy



Matteo Meucci, with roots in his father's representative office in the alpaca and mohair sector, took his first professional steps at Alpha Tops SA in Geneva. After that, he gained experience in Arequipa, specializing in alpaca

fibers and worked for a short time on the breeding farm of the Inca Group.

After his return, he took over his father's work in the representative office, where he still works today with his company Meucci & Co, and records sales of millions of alpaca tops every year. Due to a foreseeable crisis in the alpaca fiber industry, he founded Polipeli in 1988. With an entrepreneurial spirit, he took advantage of Pra-

to's textile infrastructure and developed.

Polipeli SPA to a global standard for weaving yarns with a high animal fiber content. With a focus on quality and uniqueness, Polipeli has been constantly working to optimally process alpaca and mohair fibers using the latest technologies and machinery. The company has researched innovative spinning technologies and experimented with various fiber blends, always aiming to improve quality. This pursuit of excellence is also evident in their collaboration with a French mohair goat cooperative, producing and processing thousands of kilograms of mohair yarn every year.

Matteo sees himself as a pioneer in the textile sector and would like to share his findings and experience. His journey from discovering the potential of alpaca and mohair fibers to market-leading processing is impressive and inspiring.

J. Alonso Burgos Hartley | PER

2:00 p.m. – 2:45 p.m., Breeding Goals from Pacomarca's Point of View



Born 1958 in Arequipa, Peru, J. Alonso Burgos Hartley studied economics and political science in Grinnell, Iowa. He is married and the father of two sons. He currently holds several management positions within Grupo Inca, including

Manager of the Genetic Development Division Inca Tops S.A., Executive Vice President of Colca Lodge S.A., Vice President of Colca Explorer S.A., and Director of Pachamama S.A. His previous positions include, among others, CEO of the International Alpaca Association and creator and president of the first Alpaca Fiesta in 1997.

He has been working in the alpaca textile industry for 35 years. In particular, he participated in research projects aimed at increasing the value of the alpaca fiber, with a special focus on white Huacaya alpaca and the breeding of pure black alpacas. These projects have been aimed to improve the living standards of thousands of alpaca breeders in Peru.

Alpacas are closely interwoven with Peru's history. Their fine fiber can fetch the highest prices in international markets. The challenge lies in maintaining this status by increasing the value of the fiber. In the future, he sees alpacas without guard hair and in special natural colors, especially black, as producers of valuable luxury fibers for international markets.

In his 45-minute presentation, „PACOMARCA Alpacas Genetics in Black and White“, he will present the success story of Grupo Inca's genetic improvement project.

Dr. Edgar Quispe Peña | PER

3:00 p.m.- 3:45 p.m., Fiber Laboratory in Peru



Dr. Edgar Quispe Peña, graduated at Universidad Nacional Agraria La Molina (Perú) in animal science. Currently he is professor at UNALM and researches animal breeding and camelid production.

He is CEO of Natural Fibers Tech SAC and has five patents for devices used for fiber evaluation, has more than a hundred scientific publications (details on Research Gate). He is referee and co-editor of well-known magazines, Small Ruminant Research, among others.

His enthusiasm for alpacas is rooted in his social commitment: Alpaca breeding helps alleviating

poverty, as many alpaca breeders live at the subsistence level. For him, the fiber properties of alpacas are impressive: good thermoregulation, softness, wear resistance, water-repellent and fire resistant. In addition, alpacas are ecological animals that protect the soil and can live in difficult geographical areas.

Dr. Quispe Peña predicts that alpacas will be kept worldwide in the future and could partially replace sheep. This is not only due to the valuable alpaca fiber, but also to its use in medicine, rehabilitation treatment and as companion animals.

In his 45-minute presentation, he will talk about fiber density and medullation as criteria for alpaca selection. In addition, he will present his fiber evaluation device, the Fiber EC, and demonstrate it on site.

Raul C. Rivera | PER

4:00 p.m.- 5:00 p.m., Alpaca Fleece Processing in Peru



Raul C. Rivera, MBA, University of Leicester, and BS, Fresno State University, has an impressive professional expertise in the alpaca industry. He has worked for more than 25 years at Mitchell & Cia. S.A., a leading company

in Peru, in marketing, product development and worldwide sales. In addition to his work at Mitchell & Cia. S.A., he has also taken on significant roles in the International Alpaca Association and the Arequipa Chamber of Commerce and was chairman of the 2018 Alpaca Fiesta.

Rivera's entry into the alpaca industry was coincidental when, after completing his studies in the USA, he did an internship at Mitchell & Cia. S.A. Although he had little knowledge of alpacas or the industry at the time, he was fascinated by the extensive production process from the raw material to the final product. For him, every alpaca product symbolizes not only quality, but also roots deeply in tradition and history.

Regarding the future of the alpaca industry, Rivera hopes that the breeding of alpacas will spread worldwide. For him, the breeders are important ambassadors who help to increase the awareness and recognition of the alpaca on a global scale.

In his presentation, Rivera plans to shed light on the process of transforming fibers into yarns, an expertise he has perfected over the years.
